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Construction and Traffic Highlights for the Week of 5/06/2019

(1) SOUTHERN BOULEVARD BRIDGE:

Construction continues on the Southern Boulevard Bridge.

(2) FPU GAS LINE WORK: Florida Public Utilities will be tying in and recording of sewer lines on the following streets. Please be aware of all advanced traffic warning signs and traffic control devices. Traffic will be directed by flaggers.

- Palmo Way
- Esplanade Way

(3) TOWN WIDE COCONUT PALM TRIMMING:

There will be limited lane closures with periodic blocking of parking stalls. Flaggers, advance warning signs and traffic control devices will be present to assist with traffic flow. The following streets and roadways will be affected:

NO PARKING signs will be used and enforced to insure access to trees:

(4) TOWN-WIDE UNDERGROUNDING:

PHASE 1 NORTH (ONONDAGA TO EAST INLET DRIVE)

VARIOUS LOCATIONS – Comcast continues to work throughout the entire Phase 1 North area completing service drops and switch overs.

PHASE 2 NORTH (OSCEOLA WAY TO ONONDAGA)

UNDERGROUNDING WORK - Horizontal Directional Drilling to continue along North Lake Way between Reef and Dolphin for the installation of FPL, Comcast, and AT&T conduits. Private side service conduit installation will continue on Angler, Dolphin, and Seagate.

"LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY", one lane of traffic to be maintained on all roads being worked on in both phases.

PHASE 1 SOUTH (SLOAN'S CURVE TO SOUTHERN LIMITS OF TOWN)

Florida Power and Light contractors will be working on the streetlights on South Ocean Boulevard from Sloan's Curve south to Lake Avenue. The streetlight work is anticipated to be completed by late May 2019. The contractor will be periodically closing the southbound lane of South Ocean Boulevard. Please be aware and follow all advanced warning signs and traffic control devices. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic as needed.

(5) RECREATION CENTER PROJECT (Construction):

Construction of the Town's Recreation Center building will continue. The public is cautioned to be aware of large trucks leaving the site and traveling on Royal Palm Way (westbound traffic) as construction continues on the Recreation Center. Seaview Avenue has been reduced to single lane at or near the tennis court facilities. The Town's construction manager for this project is Hedrick Brothers Construction.

(6) 400 BLOCK OF WORTH AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS:

Monday, April 29, 2019 through Thursday, October 31, 2019, The 400 Block of Worth Avenue from Coconut Row to Peruvian Avenue will have intermittent lane closures to a full road closure as the Town's contractor, C&W Pipeline, installs new water, sewer and drainage lines. Westbound vehicle and pedestrian traffic will be detoured at Coconut Row. The on-street parallel parking and handicap parking spaces within the project limits will be unavailable. The contractor will maintain access to resident's driveways.

(7) SIGNALIZATION AND MAST ARM IMPROVEMENTS:

At the intersections of Coconut Row /Clarke Avenue and at Bradley Place /Sunrise Avenue the Town's contractor will continue with the Mast Arm and Signalization Improvements Project. The contractor will be having intermittent single lane closures at the described intersections for the signal and mast arm improvements. Please follow all advanced warning signs and traffic control devices. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic as needed. Sidewalks will be closed to Pedestrian traffic. Please follow the construction signage for the sidewalks in this area.

(8) E-2 LIFT STATION REPAIRS AT MOCKINGBIRD TRAIL AND NORTH LAKE WAY:

D.S. Eakins Construction Corporation, is completing emergency sanitary sewer improvements. The contractor will be mobilizing on Monday, April 29 with a full road closure for up to 6 weeks on North Lake Way at the intersection of Mockingbird Trail. Traffic will be diverted at several locations prior to approaching the intersection to avoid all traffic using one east-west route. Please follow construction signage. Once the main components of the station are rehabilitated and tested the road impacts may be limited to a single lane closure following the 6th week of the construction schedule.

TOWN REMINDERS:

- 1. Private construction projects are limited to three (3) on-street parking permits. Adherence to this rule will improve the effectiveness of the crews collecting vegetation from the right of way.**
- 2. Landscape contractors and residents; regular collection schedules have resumed, per ordinance, during the months of May through and including the month of October, trash may be placed on the public right-of-way, adjacent to the property from which it came, not more than three days prior to the scheduled day of collection.**

RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMITS:

- There will be a lane closure on Island Road for four (4) hours. A delivery of an auger for the installation of a piling located at 624 Island Drive by tractor trailer. The work is scheduled to start on Wednesday, May 1, and end on Friday, May 31. Flaggers will be maintaining traffic. The work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-02778.
- There will be a lane closure by AT&T located at the intersection of Cocconut Row and Royal Palm Way between Brazilian Avenue and Australian Avenue along Cocconut Row. AT&T needs access to manholes for installing conduits and equipment. The work is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, May 1, and end on Wednesday, July 31. The work will be authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-03027.
- There will be a lane closure located at 280 Sunset Avenue (Bradley Park Hotel) by Florida Power and Light. Construction will consist of the installation of three (3) concrete poles on Bradley Place including a directional bore and is part of an overhead to underground conversion project. The work is scheduled to start on Wednesday, May 1, and will end on Saturday June 1. This work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-02943.
- There will be a periodic lane closures on various Town of Palm Beach roadways by Zimmerman Tree Service for trimming Cocconut Palm Trees for the Public Works Department. The work is scheduled to begin on Friday May 3, and will end on Wednesday, July 31. This work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-03009.
- There will be a lane closure located at 232 Seabreeze Avenue for a concrete pour for a home foundation. The work will take place over an 8 hour time frame and the trucks will be not be staged on the roadway. The work is scheduled to start on Thursday May 9, and end later same day. The work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-03109.
- There will be lane closures on North County Road, North Lake Way and Slope Trail for drilling soil borings at six (6) locations (between Country Club Road and Plantation Road right of ways). Three (3) of the soil borings are on north/south roadways and the remaining soil boring are located on the east/west road ways. The work is scheduled to start on Monday, May 6, and will end on Friday, June 7. The work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Numbers U-19-03079 and U-19-03080.
- There will be lane closures on Cocconut Row, South Lake Way and South Ocean Boulevard for drilling soil borings at four (4) locations (between Seaview Avenue and Australian Avenue road right of ways). All four (4) of the soil borings are located on north/south roadways. The work is scheduled to start on Monday, May 6, and will end on Friday, June 7. The work is authorized by Right of Way Permit.
- There will be a lane closure located on Palmo Way by Florida Public Utility or its contractor for Phase 2 Undergrounding, between North Ocean Way and North Lake Way for de-watering operations in conjunction with the installation of 515 LF of 2" PE natural gas main within the Town of Palm Beach road right of way. The work scheduled to start on Thursday, May 9 and end on Monday, June 10. The work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-03034.
- There will be lane closures located on South Ocean Boulevard (FDOT roadway) by Florida Public Utility or its contractor for Phase 2 Undergrounding, starting just north of Regents Park Drive and terminating at Via Fontana. The proposed work is for the installation of a 6, 370 LF of 6" natural gas main (South Ocean Boulevard) and 1, 620 LF of 2" PE natural gas main within the Town of Palm Beach road rights of ways (Regents Park Road, Blossom Way, Oceanview

Road Lagomar Road, Seagrape Circle and Via Fontana). The work is scheduled to start on Thursday, May 9 and end on Monday, November 25. The work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-03035.

- There will be a lane closure located at 264 Dunbar Road on Bradley Place Avenue for setting up a bucket truck and a line truck to relocate a power pole and relocate cables and conductors underneath the sidewalk from Bradley Place. The work is scheduled to start on Wednesday, May 1, and end on Thursday, June 13. The work is authorized by Right of Way Permit Number U-19-02938.
