VI. Public Hearings:

- A. Case # CE 21-942, 240 S. County Road, Sandra & Thomas Campaniello:
Violation of Chapter 18, Section 18-18 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires the exterior of a structure shall be maintained in good repair, structurally sound and sanitary so as not to pose a threat to the public health, safety and welfare.
- B. Case # CE 21-750, 910 S. Ocean Blvd., 910 S Ocean LLC:
Violation of Chapter 88, Section 88-18 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires the exterior of a structure shall be maintained in good repair, structurally sound and sanitary so as not to pose a threat to the public health, safety and welfare. Chapter 88, Section 88-16 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires exterior property and premises shall be maintained in a clean, safe and sanitary condition.
- C. Case # CE 21-734, 411 S. County Road, PB Worth Partners LLC:
Violation of Chapter 88, Section 88-18 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires the exterior of a structure shall be maintained in good repair, structurally sound and sanitary so as not to pose a threat to the public health, safety and welfare.
- D. Case # CE 21-746, 401 S. County Road, US Postal Service:
Violation of Chapter 38, Section 38-62 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires alarm users to first obtain a permit. Furthermore, alarm user fees not paid within 30 days accrue an automatic ten percent penalty per month and are subject to Code Enforcement action including, but not limited to filing a lien on the property. Chapter 38, Section 38-35 allows for service charges and late penalties to be assessed to alarm system owners who exceed the maximum allowable false alarms in any given calendar year beginning in October 1.
- E. Case # CE 21-615, 301 Via Linda, 301 Via Linda LLC:
Violation of Chapter 88, Section 88-18 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires the exterior of a structure shall be maintained in good repair, structurally sound and sanitary so as not to pose a threat to the public health, safety and welfare. Chapter 88, Section 88-16 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires exterior property and premises shall be maintained in a clean, safe and sanitary condition.
- F. Case # 21-94, 201 Via Bellaria, Ryna Greenbaum:
Violation of Chapter 18, Section 18-233 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances adopts the Florida Building Code which requires building permits to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish or change the occupancy of a building or structure or install, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, mechanical or plumbing system.

VII. Fine Consideration Hearing:

A. Case # CE 21-511, 425 Chilean Ave., Loraine S. Charman.:

Violation Chapter 66, Section 66-236(a) of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances vegetation removal permits, not sought in conjunction with building permits, shall be obtained by making application prior to removal, relocation or replacement of the building official or his designee, at least ten working days prior to the proposed date of removal.

B. Case # CE 21-425, 232 Colonial Lane, George & Zvenka Kleinfeld:

Violation of Chapter 18, Section 18-233 of the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances requires building permits to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish or change the occupancy of a building or structure or install, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, mechanical or plumbing system.
