



Dune Restoration 2025-26

Town of Palm Beach

Protecting our Homes and our Beaches Today and for the Future

Over the next few months, the Town will be restoring the dunes in Reaches 8 and 9 at the southern end of Palm Beach Island. Approximately 30,000 cubic yards of sand will be transported by trucks from a stockpile in the Reach 7 Phipps Ocean Park project area and placed in the dunes of Reaches 8 and 9 from the Bellaria to Imperial House, providing storm protection.




The project has several steps:

- 1 Sand will be sourced from the stockpile at Phipps Ocean Park.
- 2 Trucks will take sand from Phipps to the Atriums.
- 3 A conveyor system will transfer sand approximately 500 feet to the beach.
- 4 Sand will be spread and graded along Reach 8 and 9.
