## NOTICE FOR PROPERTY/MAINTENANCE MANAGERS

### - STRUCTURAL PAVING ONGOING THROUGH EARLY SPRING 2026

### - IRRIGATION ADJUSTMENTS PRIOR TO SOD INSTALLATION

In February and early March 2026, the contractor will be placing the first layer of new asphalt along S.R. A1A between Lake Avenue and Ibis Way as work progresses towards the final phase of the improvements project.

Once the asphalt is placed in front of a property during this timeframe, sod installation can be expected roughly two (2) to three (3) weeks after.

In the interim, properties are encouraged to perform any preferred irrigation adjustments with their maintenance crews before the sod is installed.
